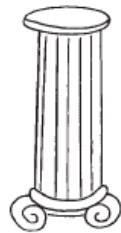

Words made from 'ped' or 'pod' with their meanings:

1. **pedal**: part of a bike for the 'foot'.
2. **pedometer**: instrument which measures the 'feet' that someone walks.
3. **pedestrian**: one who walks around on her 'feet'.
4. **biped**: animal which walks on two 'feet'.
5. **quadruped**: animal which walks on four 'feet'.
6. **centipede**: insect which has around 100 'feet'.
7. **tripod**: stand with three 'feet'.
8. **podium**: stand with one 'foot'.
9. **podiatrist**: 'foot' doctor.
10. **expedition**: a freeing of the 'feet' to travel.
