

# Test 25



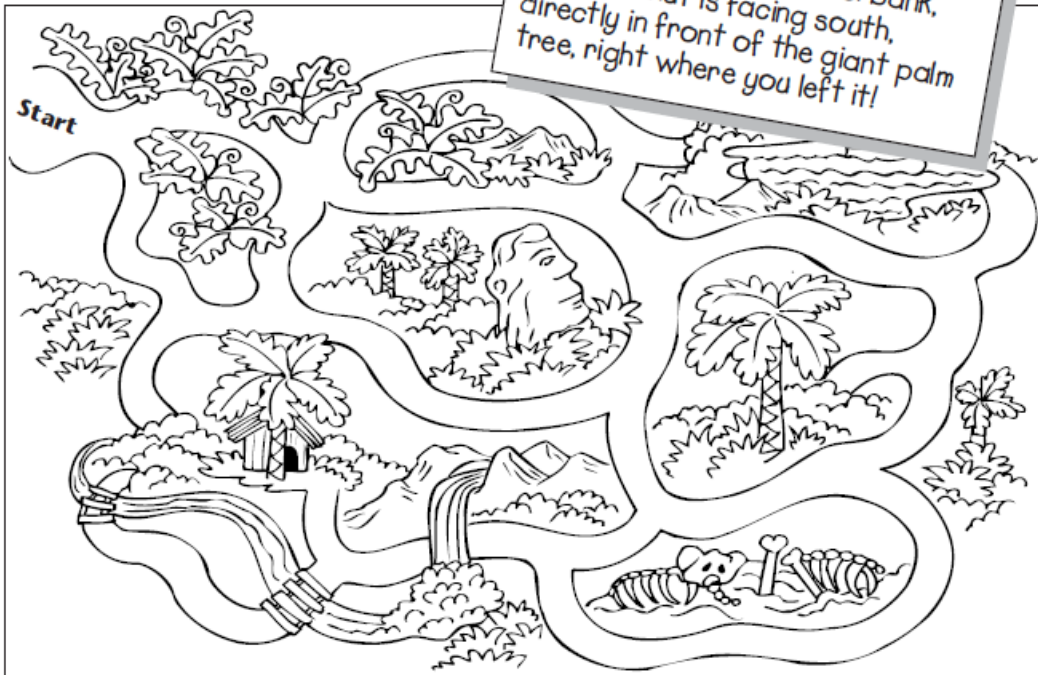
Keep on the right path. Use all you know about being a careful reader—that gets you where you need to go.

**Directions:** Read the directions carefully and use the compass to trace a path that safely leads Jungle Jim back to his hut.



While exploring the wilds of Walla-Walla in his jeep, a huge storm washed out the road that led directly back to Jungle Jim's hut. Jim needs to find a safe path back to his hut, using only his compass and Eagle Ike's directions.

- Directions**
1. Drive east along the forest of ferns until you arrive at Rock Head (a big rock that looks like a head.) Don't turn toward the lake.
  2. Go south toward the ancient elephant burial grounds.
  3. Drive west under the waterfall.
  4. Drive north up the riverbank, and your hut is facing south, directly in front of the giant palm tree, right where you left it!
